Research Organisation (ISRO)

joined by DRDO successfully conducted the Reusable Launch Vehicle Autonomous Landing Mission (RLV LEX) at the Aeronautical Test Range (ATR), Chitradurga, Karnataka on April 2, 2023.

became the newest member in a growing club of Indians holding the topmost posts at Global Tech Companies when he was appointed as the CEO of the microblogging platform Twitter. India assumed the presidency of the G20 group for 2023, with the theme – One Earth, One Family, One Future.

India successfully landed its Chandrayaan-3 mission on the lunar surface on August 23, 2023, making it the fourth country to do so after the United States, Russia, and China. The lander Vikram touched down on the south pole of the moon, a region that has never been explored before. The launch of Aditya L1 by PSLV C57 is accomplished successfully from Sriharikota. The vehicle has placed the satellite precisely in to its intended orbit. India's first solar observatory has begun its journey to the destination of Sun Earth L1 point.



## CURRENT AFFAIRS

National centre for Good Governance (NCGG) successfully trained the civil servants in Maldives. According to the RBI, India's Current Account Deficit (CAD) has been reduced to 1.3 billion dollars in the Jan-Mar quarter, 2022-23. Ajay Bhatnagar has been appointed as a special director of Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI). Moga is the mascot for the upcoming 37th National Games, that would be held in Goa. Salman Rushdie has been selected for the prestigious German Peace Prize 2023. C.A Bhavani Devi, Indian fencer secured the bronze medal at Asian Fencing Championships, 2023 held in China. In June 2023, Philippines has collaborated with India in the defence sectors, with a particular focus on the maritime domain. In July 2023, 34 Transaction Banking hubs were launched by the State Bank Of India at 21 districts centres across the country.

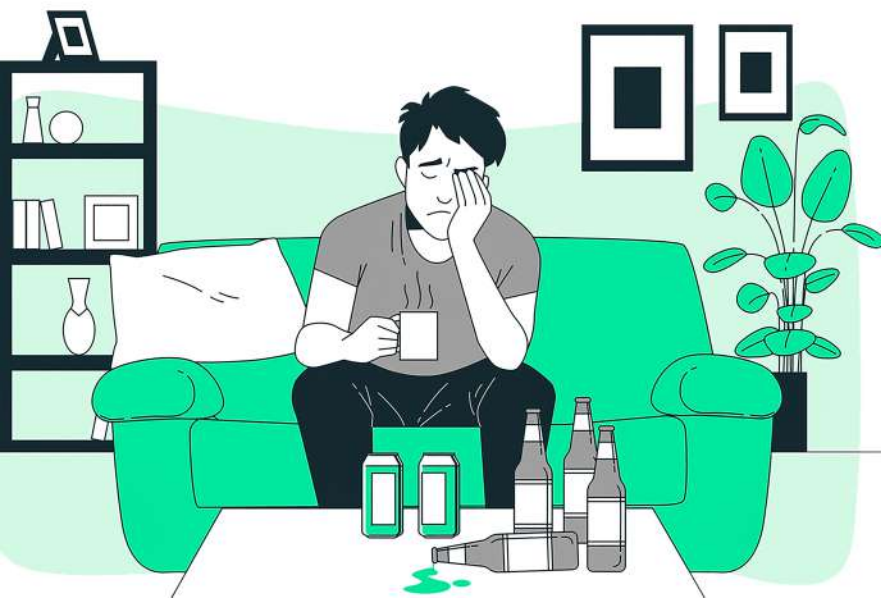
